Kathy Anderson, Treasurer, attended the meeting to discuss a CD that is expiring at the Community Credit Union. The money will be reinvested into a CD at the Credit Union for 18 months at the rate of 1.75%.

At the request of Road Superintendent Todd Weber, the Eddy County Water Resource Board attended the meeting to discuss a township road in Sections 15 and 16 of Superior Township that has culvert issues. This is a township issue, and Kenny Reis will discuss the problems with the Superior Township Board.

Dave Gehrtz, Chairperson, adjourned the meeting at 10:24 A.M. The next Special Meeting will be March 16, 2020 at 8:30 A.M.

New Rockford City Ordinance 10-04-07 and 10-04-08 states that any dead elm tree or part thereof, including logs, branches, stumps, firewood or other elm material from which the bark has not been removed must be burned or destroyed prior to April 1 of each year or you could be subject to a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or 30 days imprisonment, or both.

Woodpiles should be checked for elm wood right away. Any elm wood with the bark still attached should be separated out of the pile and burned before April 1.

Please help in saving elm trees in New Rockford and burn or destroy all elm wood in your piles before April 1. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
