CenDak has talked to the renter of the land about reimbursing him for the crop damage. The existing plant in town would be removed and the site cleaned up. The location of the hospital landfill site, costs of survey and land, and purchase agreement were discussed. Richter moved to approve the sale of said land to CenDak Cooperative pending answers to all variables mentioned. McKnight seconded. The average price for an acre of land is \$1200.00. The farm lea will be reviewed, ND Department of Health will be contacted about the hospital landfill, a survey needs to be done, and there needs to be a letter from Stephen Guler about crop damage. After the discussion, Richter re scinded his motion and McKnight rescinded her second. Article I - Procedure
2-01-07 General Penalties for Violation
In case no other specific penalty is prescribed for the violation of any section or
provision of any ordinance of the City of New Rockford, any person found guilty of violating the same shall be punished by a fine of not more than One Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$1,000.00), except that any person convicted of shoplifting, vandalism, criminal mischief, or malicious mischief shall be punished by a fine of not exceeding One be punished by a fine of not exceeding One Thousand Five Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$1,500.00), imprisonment for thirty (30) days, or both, such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the municipal judge; the municipal judge to have power to suspend said sentence, defer imposition of sentence, to revoke the suspension thereof or utilize the sentencing alternatives allowed a municipal judge under state law. Each day any person, firm, association, or corporation shall violate any section or provision of any article shall constitute a separate offense.


