Approval of the Agenda It was moved by Larson and seconded by Perleberg to approve the agenda as presented with the additions of Item C - Community Fund Transfer, Item D - Public Survey Results, Item E - Interview Committee Process. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of the March 11th Regular Meeting Minutes, March 8th Special Meeting Minutes, March 20th Special Meeting Minutes It was moved by Jacobson and seconded by Larson to approve the minutes of the March 11th Regular Meeting Minutes, March 18th Special Meeting Minutes, March 20th Special Meeting Minutes as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of the Consent Agenda

It was moved by Alfstad and seconded by Perleberg to approve the consent agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously. The consent agenda consisted of the business manager report, and the bills - general fund of \$188,793.19, the school lunch fund of \$20,077.98 and the activity fund of \$1,793.54.

Monthly Committee Reports There were no committee meetings to report.

Principals' Reports Principal Becker shared her report to the board. A check in with the stronger connections grant, which funds SOS and PBIS was recently held. Elementary Academic Challenge was recently held in Fessenden with two team of six. Grades participating were the fourth, fifth and sixth. Work on teacher evaluations is about half complete of the twenty four evaluations total. Elementary staff planning for summer school is underway. Lastly, it was noted that Becker will be attending a Cognition conference in Bismarck later this month.

Superintendent Report Dr. Louters was not present this evening. Her report was available to the board in print form.

Teacher Report Elementary physical education teacher Nathan Jensen spoke to the board. Early elementary is currently working on gross motor skills, and space awareness. Seeing lots of improvement as the year goes by with the younger students in these areas. \$3,800 was raised during the kid's heart challenge recently. Lastly Jensen noted that the district was recently awarded the All Kid's Bike campaign grant. The grant allowed the District to purchase 20 strider bikes for use in teaching all elementary kids to ride bike.

Student Report There was no student report this evening.

Systematic Grade Level Configuration It was moved by Jacobson and seconded by Price to approve the systematic grade level configuration as presented. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. The change will list the district with the state as how classes are currently structured. Change will list the district as K-5, 6-8, and 9-12.

Be Legendary Program The item was tabled previously and was brought back for additional discussion. The decision was made to table the item again, until the next school year to allow proper time and focus on the coming months' tasks at hand.

Community Foundation Transfer It was moved by Perleberg and seconded by Jacobson to approve the request the transfer or withdrawal of \$35,039.87 from the New Rockford-Sheyenne Public School Non-Endowment Fund for the purpose of paying Pace Fundraising as per the contract previously signed, as presented. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.

Public Survey Results No motion on the table tonight as item as just public discussion. A community survey was recently conducted to gather input from the community on what they would like to see in the next Superintendent. Survey results were provided and discussed.

Interview Committee Process It was moved by Jacobson and seconded by Price to approve the hiring committee to consist of one high school teacher, one elementary teacher, and administration with the exception of any individual who has applied for the position. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.

Discussion was held on who should be on the Superintendent hiring committee in preparation for the Superintendent search.

Under the measure, no person may be elected or appointed to serve any portion of a term representing North Dakota in the U.S. Senate or the U.S. House of Representatives if that person could be 81 years old by December 31 of the year immediately preceding the end of the term, and any such person is prohibited from appearing on the ballot. If a superior law requires age-limited candidates to appear on the ballot in a primary or general election, the candidates' age on December 31 of the year immediately preceding the end of the term they are seeking must be printed next to the names of all candidates for all federal legislative offices in future elections. The article also requires the Attorney General to zealously defend Section 4 of the article in the courts of this state or of the United States. The article would become effective immediately upon approval by the voters. If the measure conflicts with any other provision of the state constitution, the measure states it would prevail over the other constitutional provisions.
