Donna Young went over the Weed Board budget and explained the need of equipment for spraying. Young also noted that spraying will take place this fall, after the ditches are mowed. It was discussed that Young should get a light on top of Ranger, mirrors and anything else to make it street legal. Young was also directed to get prices for the equipment needed for spraying that will fit the Ranger, as her current equipment does not.

Denton Heisley went over the Lake Region District Health Unit budget. Heisley reported a 2.5%

salary increase over prior year. Travis Peterson, Monty Schaefer, Kenny Reis and Mike Tweed from the Water Resource Board presented their budget request. Peterson noted that in 2023 \$25,000 was requested and in 2024 \$30,0000 was requested and approved, however no mills were levied in 2023 or 2024 and therefore WRB did not receive funds from levied tax dollars in those years. It was discussed that this was due to the Water Resource Board having funds available, and no reported projects. The budget request for 2025 was \$50,000. The Board reported that there are clean out projects that are being considered.

The holding tanks at the Eddy County Fairgrounds continue to fill with water when water is shut off. Commission will look into replacing septic tanks. Kristy O'Connor, Eddy County

Tax Assessor presented a propos-

al for Eddy County to take own-

ership of the Vanguard Appraisal Software License. The license is currently held by the City of New Rockford; however, the program is housed in Tax Assessor's office, and is the only user. The fee schedule was also reviewed.

Glenda Collier made a motion to move the Vanguard Appraisals Software License upon renewal to Eddy County from the City of New Rockford and to update the fee schedule as presented. Dave Gehrtz seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Glenda Collier gave an update on the Central Prairie Human Service Zone cost reimbursement distribution. The Eddy County Weed Board is offering a cost share program for chemical for control of noxious weeds on qualifying land. Cost share rates are as follows:

- 80% cost share for Tordon up to IO gallons
- 50% cost share for 2-4D up to 20 gallons - The 2-4D must be tank mixed with Tordon at 2:1
 - (2 parts 2-4D to I part Tordon)
- 80% cost share for Plateau (or the generic version) up to
- 50% cost share for Milestone up to 5 gallons

In order to receive reimbursement, you must submit:

(I) Invoice or receipt to prove purchase of chemical (2) A copy of the maps with sprayed areas highlighted (3) The legal description of the land sprayed

We will ${\color{red} {\bf NOT}}$ accept an invoice with a name on it and then it whited out and a different name handwritten over the top or something to that affect. If you want to take advantage of the full reimbursement limits, plan ahead when you are buying the chemical.
